



Fishing is Fun! 2025 TWF/NTC Tournament Format

The Nebraska Walleye Association Kids Fishing Clinics Charity, Inc. as a member of The Walleye Federation is allotted 2025 NTC entries if four tournaments are held. This year they will be held to support the **Fishing is Fun!** clinics at the NWA Tournament locations listed below.

The **April 26th Calamus Reservoir** clinic will be held at Calamus Marine- following the end of the NWA tournament with a show up time at **4:00 pm**. Clinic starts at **4:30 pm**.

The **May 31st Harlan County Reservoir** clinic will be held at 'Waconda Boats' in Republican City following the end of the Saturday NWA tournament weigh-in. Times to be announced usually 4:30.

The **July 12th Lake McConaughy** clinic will be held at the 'Lured In' in Ogallala following the end of the Saturday NWA tournament weigh-in. Times to be announced usually 4:30.

The **August 23rd Lewis & Clark Reservoir** clinic will be held at the 'Weigand Marina' following the end of the Saturday Kevin J Murray tournament weigh-in. Times to be announced usually 4:30.

Fishing is Fun! Tournament Rules:

No monetary entry fee required to enter the **Fishing is Fun!** tournament.

Teams must be paid entries & fish in each of the NWA Tournaments scheduled for those locations.

Both members of the team must be a current 2025 NWA member and 2025 TWF member before the first tournament .

Both members of the team must sign the NGPC volunteer form and assist at the kid's clinics.

Team members do not have to be certified fishing instructors, but are encouraged to be such.

All rules of the 2025 NWA Tournaments will be followed, **except that Top Gun Awards will be based on points from these four(4) clinic tournaments only.**

There will be no TWF side pot for the Fishing is Fun Tournaments.

Points allotted will be the same point system used to determine the NWA Top Gun standing.

2025 NTC entries will be offered based upon TWF allotment guidelines.

****If NTC invitations are available to the Fishing Is Fun! Club, teams with the highest scores from helping with the four kids clinics held at the tournaments will be selected. Teams will have the opportunity to accept the invitation or decline (if they no longer wish to attend or want to accept a bid from a different organization.) Both team members for that tournament (or their substitute) must help at the clinic to earn points. The Fishing-Is-Fun President will work down the FIF Clinic Points List until all invitations have been awarded to qualifying members in the event that extra slots are awarded or anglers accept an invite from another organization.
